Neighbourhood Plan survey

There is still time to have your say on how you would like to see Burbage develop in the next 20 years. The Burbage Neighbourhood Plan is currently under review and residents can help to shape it for the future by completing an online



survey, which can be found on the Parish Council website or by scanning the QR code here. The revised plan will help to steer the development of the parish from 2026 to 2041.

Pitch perfect

Burbage Parish Council, in partnership with FC Burbage, has been picked by **Leicestershire & Rutland County Football Association** to promote a grass pitch maintenance programme which is improving turfed playing surfaces across the region. The Football Foundation-funded scheme is putting more than **£68,000** into improving 9 pitches across the parish over a six-year period, focussing on surfaces at Britannia Road, Colts Close, Rugby Road and Sketchley Hill Park (Tilton Road). A Helping Hand



A new name on Burbage War Memorial will be officially unveiled at this year's Remembrance service on **Sunday November 10**.





Although listed on a memorial in Rangoon, he had not been commemorated in the UK until the Parish Council paid for his name to be added to the Church Street cenotaph earlier this year.

His daughter, Burbage resident Ann Smith, will perform an unveiling as part of this year's commemorations, to be led by the Revd Andrew Hall of St Catherine's Church, following a traditional parade from Grove Road.

Burbage Christmas market

Christmas comes to Burbage on **Friday November 29**, with a festive fair and market on Windsor Street and attractions around the village.

The Royal British Legion Burbage Branch is again partnering with the Parish Council to co-ordinate the street event, which will run from 4.30pm to 9.30pm and feature fairground rides, market stalls, food, drink, music and more. Santa is also due to attend.
