PCSO of the year

The Parish Council was delighted to hear that Burbage PCSO Darren Stretton has been named Police Community Support Officer of the year by Leicestershire Police. PCSO 6035 Stretton is based at Millennium Hall, near to the Parish Office, and works closely with Council Members and staff to address issues of concern for residents, including speeding traffic and anti-social behaviour. He was awarded the accolade previously, in 2020.
