The Parish Council has been given £5,000 which it is to award as grants of up to £500 to support charitable and community projects benefitting Burbage. Hinckley Park developer IMProperties has donated the money from a pot of £100,000 which is being used to support schemes across the wider Hinckley & Bosworth borough. Burbage Gardening Club's 75th annual open show at Hastings High School on August 19, of which the Parish Council was a sponsor, collected donations totalling more than £410 for its chosen charity, Canine Partners.

3G Pitch at Britannia Road

Consultation event...

Back in June the Parish Council launched a community vote to gauge residents' preference for the potential siting of a 3G football pitch on parish green space at either Rugby Road Park or Britannia Road Recreation Ground. The project, in association with FC Burbage and in partnership with both the Football Foundation and Leicestershire and Rutland County Football Association, is **still at the scoping phase.** Survey results revealed the strongest support for Britannia Road Recreation Ground. In addition, detailed site studies carried



out by the Football Foundation to ascertain ground suitability for installing a 3G pitch at either site revealed some difficult constraints with the Rugby Road Park site, meaning that **the only viable option for a potential 3G pitch is at Britannia Road Recreation Ground.**
