Burbage 3G sports facility

What's been happening

Last September the Parish Council held a **consultation event** to share information and gather views on the possibility of securing a 3G artificial grass pitch at Britannia Road Recreation Ground, alongside a **public survey** which ran until October 13 last year. The consultation event was well attended, and the survey **feedback was very positive**, with 236 responses received.

Full survey data can be viewed on the Council's website by clicking **About the Council** on the home page menu and then clicking **Public Consultations**.

The Britannia Road proposal was put on hold when a potential alternative site at Hastings High School was put forward in the autumn but after exhaustive efforts, it was concluded in January this year that the school was not a viable option.

With Britannia Road remaining the only potential site in Burbage, the Parish Council sought a **pre-application planning opinion** from the local planning authority. The response from the Borough's planners indicated that **a formal application would be looked upon favourably** if the details were to meet the Borough and Sport England's policies and recommendations. A copy of the pre-application response can also be viewed on the Parish Council's website as above.

.... What happens next

At a meeting on May 13, encouraged by the positive survey feedback and favourable preapplication planning response, Burbage Parish Council endorsed moving forward, together with local community partner FC Burbage, to a **formal application to the Football Foundation** for funding of a 3G artificial grass pitch at Britannia Road Recreation Ground.

Despite some delays in the scoping phases, a dedicated group of Councillors, members

of FC Burbage and other stakeholders is now working closely with the Football Foundation to progress through the formal framework with the aim of delivering a much-needed 3G pitch for Burbage in Spring/Summer 2026.
